## OTHER EXPENSES

### 1. Camps

- Year 3 - \$40, Year 4 -6 \$300, Year 7 - \$360, Year 9 EDGE (2 camps) - \$760, Year 11 - \$410.
- Camps are *compulsory* and it is expected that all students attend.

### 3. GBC Private Bus Services

- Full time travel is \$35 per week, per student equating to \$1400.
- Part time travel is \$25.50 per week, per student equating to \$1020.

This is a subsidised cost attained when parents complete their Conveyance Allowance form.

- Occasional travel is \$5 per trip. Occasional passes are purchased from the Office.

### 4. Uniforms
